Content	The review is completely relevant to the topic, describing the decor /atmosphere, service and facilities in separate paragraphs. Organization and cohesion	There is complete logical connection of paragraphs due to a judicious use of linking devices, mechanics, and length requirements. Paragraphs are partially complete due to unfinished ideas and scarce use of linking devices, mechanics, and length requirements.
